We have selected the above items on the basis that:

1. Peninsular Retreat Centre is a 3 level brick, glass and wood building. Possible/probable disasters are Fire, Earthquake and storms.
2. The Retreat Centre is situated in close proximity to housing developments and the main townships of Frankston, Baxter, Karingal etc. More and more housing developments are being built in the area.

Taking these two aspects into account, the building could well be damaged and/or neighbours could suffer extensive damage and harm.

Others (BKs and the general public) may well seek refuge at the Retreat Centre, or require help.

One of the main (if not the main) practise of the BKs is benevolence and it would be expected that the BKs would check on neighbours and other BKs to see if they required help and be prepared to help as much as possible - hence the suggested equipment & stores listed.
