With over 40 years of experience she is a spiritual expert on how the quality of thought impacts the quality of matter in all domains. Since 2009 she has been the head of Brahma Kumaris delegation to all the UN climate change conferences explaining the link between spirituality and sustainability.

Anna Leidreiter, policy officer she coordinates policy research and advocacy campaigns in the climate energy team of the World Future Council. In her main capacity Anna works on enabling policy frameworks for a global energy transition towards 100% renewable energies. Besides that, Anna is member of the supervisory board of an energy cooperative in the North of Germany.

Dieter Lünse, founder of the institute for constructive conflict resolution and mediation e.V. in Hamburg, founder of the circle of experts for violence prevention in Hamburg. His interest is the prevention of social anonymization and violence in the social space, the coalesced of social communities.

Joachim Golo Pilz, director of the Solar Research Institute in India. He has played a key role since 1993 in establishing the Brahma Kumaris World Spiritual University as one of the major users of renewable energies in India. Presently Golo Pilz is coordinating the design and construction of **India One**, a 1MW solar thermal power plant, www.india-one.net. He advocates sustainable solutions through an ethical and value-based approach.
