Golo Joachim Pilz was born in 1960 in Frankfurt, Germany and joined in 1984 the Brahma Kumaris, a worldwide spiritual organisation with its headquarters in Mount Abu, Rajasthan, India. Golo is an experienced meditation teacher who lectures on a wide range of spiritual and environmental topics and has travelled to more than 75 countries. He advocates sustainable solutions through an ethical and values-based approach.

In 1989, he founded the charitable trust IndiaCare with headquarters in Berlin and had been its president for more than 14 years. Since its foundation, IndiaCare has regularly supported various medical and scientific projects in India.

In 1990 Golo moved to India and founded the Brahma Kumaris Solar Department. He is currently the adviser for renewable energy of the Brahma Kumaris and its sister organisation, the World Renewal Spiritual Trust (WRST). With technical and financial collaboration from the Indian and German Governments, Golo has initiated various innovative research projects focused on rural adaptation.

In 2009, Golo became a founding member of the Brahma Kumaris Environment Initiative and, each year since, has participated and lectured at the UN climate change conferences.

From 2010 to 2017, Golo has coordinated the design and construction of India One, a 1MW solar thermal power plant at the Shantivan Campus of the Brahma Kumaris / WRST.

In 2021 Golo co-founded the meditation platform Yogis for Future. This new initiative by the Brahma Kumaris invites like-minded people to come together, meditate and create good thoughts and intentions for the wellbeing of humans and the planet.
